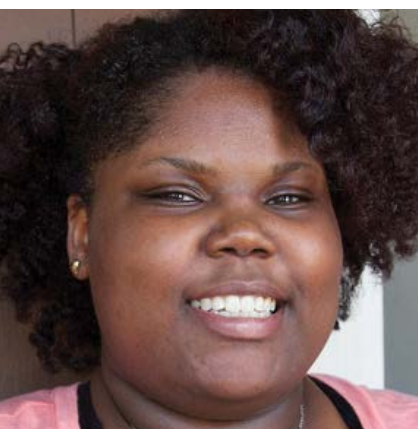

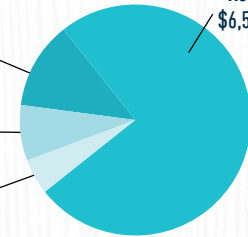

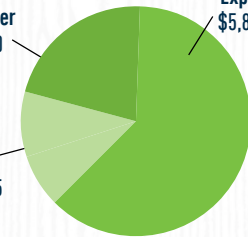

anything from anyone. I was going to do it on my own. No one even knew I was homeless. ”

I worked full-time at a non-profit in 2012. When they lost their funding, I lost my job and housing. I lived in a shelter for 12 months, where it is tough! They will eat you alive. Even though I have been able to secure a decent job, the most hours they will give me provides \$12,000 annually—not enough to be able to afford my own apartment. Through the Caritas Housing Platform Partnership, the CAREY Program found me my Caritas home. CAREY provides the support, and Caritas provides the home. I can now finish my GED, go to college and build a good future. I could not do this without these two organizations working together. I am so grateful every day.

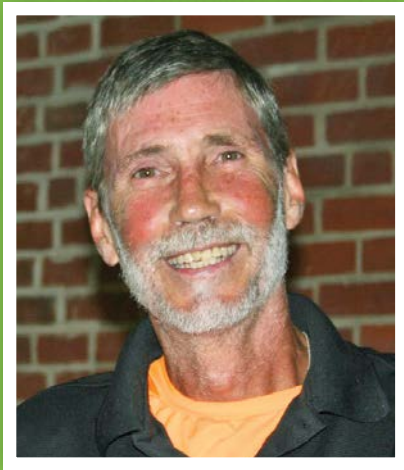

“I’M DAMAGED GOODS.

Being here is finally healing me.”


In the navy, I was involved in beach landings and hostage rescues—things too painful to talk about. After my service, I bought a house, had a job and a girlfriend until the economy tanked and I lost all I had. I became homeless and lived in a neighbor’s unheated garage for a year. When I couldn’t bear it any longer, I moved deep into the woods of a local state park. After nine months, the isolation and the weather became unbearable. A friend convinced me to talk to someone at the VA, which is how I found my Caritas home at the Bedford Veterans Quarters (BVQ) a little over a year ago.

Though I still suffer from PTSD, the BVQ has helped me to feel normal again. I have my own space, which is very important to me. I’m around other veterans who have been in the same boat. Being here really brought me back into the fold of the human race.

“ONE BAD TOOTHACHE
and I almost lost my housing.”

Three months ago, because of issues with my teeth, my face swelled to twice its normal size. I had no insurance, and after weeks of sitting in my room crying from the pain, I learned about a free dental clinic, where they pulled my nerve-damaged teeth. As an hourly wage employee, I was not getting paid while I was out and fell behind on my rent. I was so scared of being evicted. When the Caritas site and property managers told me that I had been awarded funds to help pay my rent, I was ecstatic and relieved. I wasn't going to lose my home. I know homelessness. It's unbearable. Now I am back on track, able to look forward to one day owning my own home again as I did years ago.



HOMELESSNESS PREVENTION FUND

By providing emergency funds to cover rent during a temporary setback, residents scarcely making ends meet do not have to fear losing their home due to a few days of missed work because of illness, lost work hours or other circumstances beyond their control.

I served for four years in the National Guard and for four years in active duty as a medic during Desert Storm when PTSD set in. After 16 months of shelter life and treatment, I was in need of a home I could afford. I continued my full-time work at a non-profit helping veterans advocate for benefits, a job I love. When I found my Caritas home in 2009, everything came together. Then in 2010, I earned the position of site manager.

Caritas gives people second chances if they falter. I feel grateful for my full-time job with the veterans, and I am blessed for the opportunity Caritas gave me, both personally and professionally. They have opened my eyes to managing different walks of life and the true meaning of forgiveness and generosity.

DEAR FRIENDS,

Every day your generous support enables us to provide affordable housing to hundreds of very low income individuals. This housing provides an essential base from which our residents have a chance to build a better future.

With continued reductions in public funding for housing, we devote enormous energy and time researching and pursuing public and private funding opportunities and evaluating potential real estate opportunities in communities in and around Boston that fit our single room occupancy (SRO) model so that we can help more people in need. As you read this letter, we have exciting real estate developments underway at both Cortes Street in Bay Village and D Street in South Boston, our case managers are successfully connecting residents to essential support services and our Homelessness Prevention Fund is keeping residents in their homes during times of temporary financial crisis.
