With 50-plus years in commercial real estate, Kevin Phelan is a Co-Chairman at the Boston office of Colliers, a global leader in commercial real estate services and investment management. Through the many civic and business cross-sections of his career, he has been able to network and mentor others with their philanthropic and professional endeavors. Whether determining the right lender for a borrower's property, helping a young person find their first job after graduation, or working with boards to build and enhance their efforts, he continues to be motivated by finding solutions.
